Locality

Beaverton is located adjacent to southwest Portland, Oregon. It is the 5th largest city in the Metro area. A culturally diverse and highly educated population reflects the major employers, including, Intel, Nike, Tektronix and Columbia Sportswear, as well as thriving small businesses and creative startups.

Within two blocks of the church there are two city parks, the main library, the Beaverton Farmers' Market, and access to light rail and buses with service to Portland. Nearby, freeways allow convenient travel by car throughout the metro area and to the Portland International Airport.

A wide variety of housing is available within the vicinity of the church, including single-family, townhouses, condos and apartments.

The International School of Beaverton was named Oregon's best public high school, according to U.S. News and World Report in 2024

Physical Description

Beaverton and the metro area are intersected by the Willamette and Columbia Rivers. The area is renowned for its public gardens, parks, and many hiking and cycling endeavors.

The climate is temperate, and seasonal changes make ideal conditions for hiking, boating, and growing all types of plants in spring, summer and fall. In late fall, skies turn gray bringing NW rain to feed the forests and streams, and snow to the nearby mountains for winter fun.

Unity of Beaverton's vision of a perfect ministry is one that teaches and reaches. It teaches that the Christ-spirit, as exemplified by Jesus and other great teachers, lives in everyone, not just a chosen few; that God shows up everywhere and at all times, and that we have access to the attributes of God through meditation, prayer, and service.

A perfect ministry is not confined by four walls or measured by the number of people in the pews on a given Sunday. Rather, it reaches out into the community with whatever resources it has to "go forth with zeal and enthusiasm" to fulfill its mission.
