OVERVIEW

The Verde Valley area is a viticulture region – with plenty of vineyards in the area. As it's in north central Arizona, it has wonderful opportunities for outdoor activities of every kind – fishing, biking, horseback-riding, and outstanding skiing just to the north.

We are 10 miles down the road from Sedona which, as you know, is a destination for spiritual seekers and outdoor enthusiasts from all around the world. Cottonwood, where we are, serves people from Cottonwood, Clarkdale, Camp Verde, Cornville, Sedona. The immediate local population is about 25,000.
