About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

We are across the street from the Gulf of Mexico, in the greater Tampa Bay area with easy access to Tampa International and St. Petersburg/Clearwater airports. This west central area of Florida is home to many professional sports teams and countless cultural and tourist attractions in Tampa, St. Petersburg, Sarasota, Orlando, and beyond. With our beautiful weather, and many nature and water activities, we are a lovely mix of retirement, snowbird and family communities. Pinellas County is also a tourist area that attracts visitors from around the world. We are home to a number of Unity centers and retired Unity ministers who tend to stay or relocate here. There is a strong network of minister associations and connections here.

Our community is committed to the roots and spiritual principals of Unity. We are a supportive caring community dedicated to spiritual growth. We have an active Prayer Chaplain program; a Book Club; and ongoing classes based on Unity principles. We support the local community by giving to the local food pantry and hosting A Course in Miracles group and the Dunedin Toastmasters Club. We have well-functioning committees and teams that organize the daily and weekly operations of the church community. Fellowship is a major part of our community.

Locality: On a well-traveled two-lane street, just north of downtown Dunedin and across the street from the Gulf of Mexico. We are located in northern Pinellas County, which is the most populous county in Florida.

Physical Description: Concrete block, one-story building, with 2,900 square feet. There are two main rooms: a sanctuary and a fellowship hall, with two newly renovated bathrooms.
