What Is the Leaders of Vision Award?

Leaders of Vision is an award program designed to celebrate and honor YOU'ers for the work they do in their chapters. The purpose of the Leaders of Vision Award is to deepen teens' spiritual development and leadership skills. Each year the YOU'ers can choose to develop their skills in one or more of the following areas: Prayer, Service or Leadership. Each area has specific requirements to fulfill in order to receive the YOU Leaders of Vision Award. YOU'ers must complete the application with their YOU sponsor and Minister. Candidates who complete all three areas will receive, in addition to the previous three awards, the Leaders of Vision Plaque. Recipients will be honored each year at the International Youth of Unity Event.

The application and summary of activities must be submitted to the Association of Unity Churches International by June 1 of each year.

Areas of Growth

YOU'ers may choose one or more of the following areas to work in. Books must come from the recommended reading list. If you would like to use a book not on the list, please contact the YOU coordinator at you@unity.org for approval. A creative art expression can be anything from a poem, painting, drawing, or a three-dimensional expression. Candidates may submit a photo of their creative art expression instead of the original project.

Prayer

- Read two books from the recommended reading list and present two lessons, one from each book to your YOU chapter. Lesson plans must be completed using the recommended lesson format.
- Meet quarterly with your minister and sponsor to discuss progress in your planning and ideas you have from your reading.
- Plan and organize a prayer vigil for your Chapter. Submit summary.
- Meet with your minister to lead a prayer and meditation for your congregation or develop a prayer partnership with Silent Unity or to lead a prayer or meditation at your regional rally.
- Submit a creative art expression about your experience.

Service

- Read two books from the recommended reading list and present two lessons, one from each book, to your YOU chapter. Lesson plans must be completed using the recommended lesson format.
- Meet quarterly with your minister and sponsor to discuss progress in your planning and ideas you have from your reading.
- Plan and organize a service project in your church home for your YOU chapter to participate in. Submit summary.
- Plan and organize a service project in your local community for your YOU chapter to participate in. Submit summary.
- Submit a creative art expression about your experience.

Leadership

- Read two books from the recommended reading list and present two lessons, one from each book, to your YOU chapter. Lesson plans must be completed using the recommended lesson format.
- Meet quarterly with your minister and sponsor to discuss progress in your planning and ideas you have from your reading.
- Plan, organize and facilitate a YOU business meeting. Submit summary.
- Plan, organize and facilitate a chapter event. Submit summary.
- Submit a creative art expression about your experience.

Lesson Format

Three-Part Lesson Plan

- 1. **Opening** Sets the mood and intention of your lesson time. A good opening has at least three components from the list. For example, I like to use prayer, the *Daily Word*, and share something from your week. This gives the group a chance to center creating a safe place to deepen the sharing later.
 - Prayer
 - Meditation
 - Daily Word
 - Affirmation
 - Sharing or check in
- 2. **Lesson Exploration** This is the main part of your lesson. You can be creative by using activities, role playing, and creative expression. What is your main idea for this lesson? How will you share it? How will you make it interactive? What experience do you want your class to have? A good lesson will use one or more of the listed ideas.
 - Creative expression clay, markers, paper, glitter, etc.
 - Interactive role play, games
 - Experiential games, trust activity
- 3. **Closing** Sets the tone for the next class. Remember to honor this time as well because it allows for the practice of the law of mind action through tithing and prosperity. Bless your offering and time spent together.
 - Offering
 - Blessing
 - Sharing
 - Closing prayer
