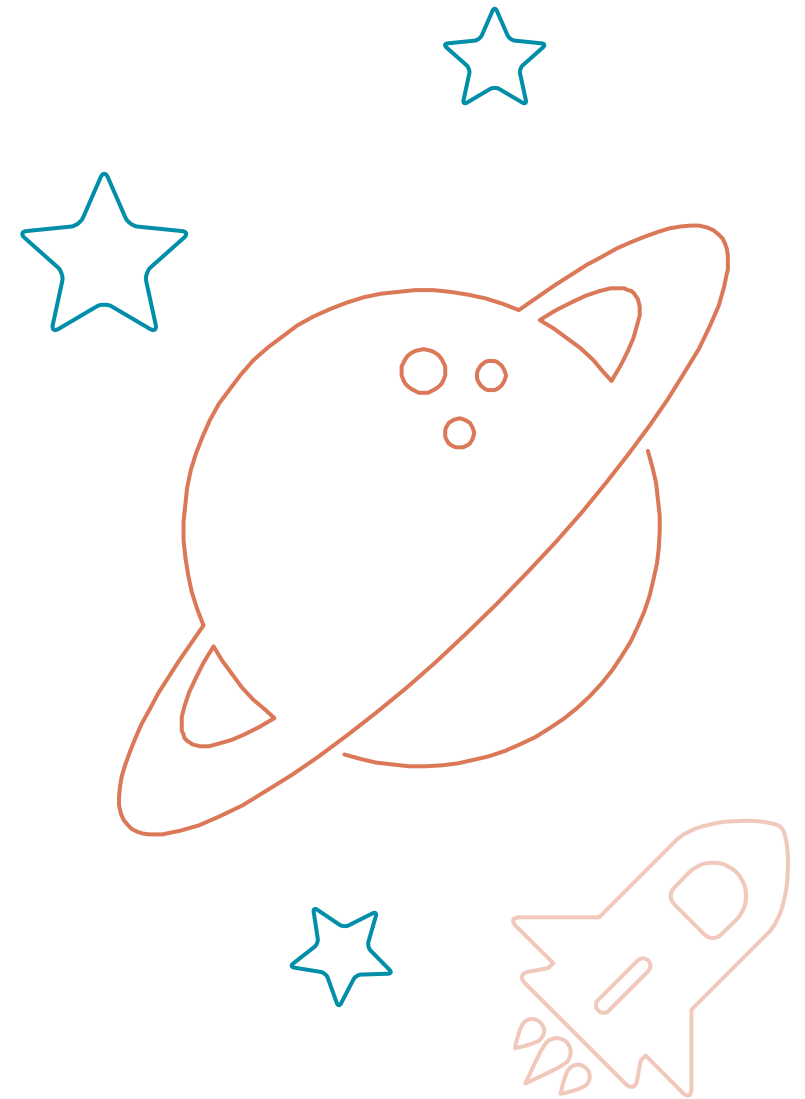


Purpose

The following guidelines establish clear expectations, consistency, and accountability for participation in the LEAP Program. These guidelines lay the foundation for UWM to support ministries by granting funds for the creation, growth, and success of innovation.

INNOVATION

Eligibility

This program is available to partner ministries, who have “skin in the game” for the project

Evolving and alternative ministries with Unity leaders who are supporting UWM are also eligible.



Requirements

- are in alignment with at least one or two of the Unity Ministry Pillars
- are easily implemented
- are subsequently sustainable
- are replicable to other ministries in the movement.
