About the Ministry

OVERVIEW

Unity of Ocala is a spiritual community rooted in Unity core teachings and dedicated to awakening the Christ presence within each person. We are a loving, inclusive, and diverse congregation located in the heart of Central Florida horse country. Our congregation is composed of about 40–50 dedicated individuals who attend in person and virtually, and we maintain a broader community of supporters through classes, outreach, and social media.

While we face some of the same challenges as many small ministries, we also have tremendous assets: a debt-free facility with room for growth, a group of committed members and volunteers, and a clear spiritual vision. We are seeking a minister to lead us into our next chapter—someone with high spiritual consciousness who values prayer, teaching, fellowship and collaborative leadership.

Locality: Ocala and Surrounding Areas

Physical Description: Ocala is nestled in Marion County in North Central Florida, known for its rolling pastures, oak-lined roads, and world-famous thoroughbred horse farms. We are a short drive from several large natural springs, the Ocala National Forest, and the Gulf and Atlantic coasts. A wide variety of interesting landmarks and hidden gems exist in all directions. Our climate is mild in winter and warm in summer with abundant sunshine year-round.

Demographics: Marion County's population is approximately 428,000 (2024). Ocala is growing steadily with a mix of retirees, families, and working professionals. This general part of Florida is growing as a retirement destination as retirees are avoiding big cities. The cost of living is lower than in many other parts of Florida.
