Unity's Religious Emblems Program is for youth working closely with adults in achieving a basic spiritual understanding. Awards can be earned at each of three different age levels.

The program was created especially for national youth groups:

- Boy Scouts of America
- Camp Fire, Inc.
- Girl Scouts of the USA
- 4-H Club
- Other Youth Groups
- Any Unity member of the specified age.

Youths can participate with an organization or as an individual. Also, any Unity church can bring together a group of young people of a designated age group to work on the requirements using the workbook.

God in Me For ages 6-10

Purpose: To help children deepen their faith and further their knowledge of the Christ within. Earning this award provides an opportunity for them to relate closely with their parents or guardians, mentors and ministers on the subject of Truth.

Light of God For ages 11-13

Purpose: To give young people a practical method to achieve a basic spiritual understanding of the truths taught by Unity, to support and recognize youths for their achievements in the presence of the church body and to provide recognition with participating youth organizations.

Fillmore Youth Award For ages 14-18

Purpose: To help the teen achieve a greater understanding of:

- Self and who they are
- The laws and principles of practical Christianity as taught by Unity
- The personal, indwelling Christ
- How to relate and integrate spiritual principles into daily life.

How Do I Get Started?

- With your parents, talk with your minister about how to earn the award and who could be the mentor to work with you. Download workbook for the appropriate age at www.unity.org/emblem.
- 2. Work through all the activities in the award booklet, asking for assistance whenever needed.
- 3. After completing all the activities, have the minister sign and send the application for the award to Unity Worldwide Ministries' Education Department.
- 4. When the emblem arrives, you and your minister select a date for presentation of the award at an appropriate church service.

Distinguished Youth Services Award Adults working with Unity youth may be nominated to receive this award.

- The certificate and pendant will be awarded with no additional charge.
