THE MINISTRY - OVERVIEW

Our Mission is to transform consciousness of our members, town, region, country, and world through teaching, mentoring, and exemplifying Unity principles. The first focus is to provide guidance, education, and awareness in our congregation and community, providing the tools necessary to impact the world by our small contributions. We recognize that all is well when working in Divine Order, and that our humanness continually needs Presence and Awareness to be able to grow, no matter what point or path each of us is on.

Unity on the River formed in 1994 as a prayer and study group by Rev. Shipley Allinson, who was called to become a Unity Minister, growing to be one of the largest Unity churches in the northeast region. In January 2015, Rev. Shipley retired from active ministry and Rev. Ogun Holder came on to be the Senior Minister until May 2021, when he answered the call to widen his audience beyond one congregation and relocated to the greater Washington, DC/Maryland area. We sold our Amesbury church property in December 2019, fortuitously just prior to the COVID-19 endemic, allowing UOTR to continue to exist and provide enriching services and programs via electronic means, and maintain the economic viability of our church.

We are flexible and cognizant of the current times with housing costs rising and commercial real estate challenging. As with our services, we are comfortable with a hybrid environment for our Senior Minister, including part to full time, remote becoming local, and the many possible paths in between.

We have a rented office space in Salem, MA, a physical service location at a synagogue in Newburyport, MA, live streaming, and fantastic offerings of music ministry, prayer chaplain services, Youth Ministry, Social Justice, Spirit Groups, connections with other church and social entities in the area, three LUTs, office staff, and Board of Trustees in a spirit guided environment.
