About The Ministry

Our Story

Unity of the Valley was founded in 1990 by Rev. Audrey Peterson, who was encouraged to establish a congregation "south of the river," by her minister at Unity South in Bloomington, MN.

In her 23-year tenure, before retiring in 2013, the congregation celebrated deep energy, vibrant community and robust programming for youth and adults, alike. We went from renting to purchasing our own building. We had Spring and Fall social and fundraising galas, successful fundraising campaigns, an active choir, well-attended community events, and a growing membership.

In the decade to follow, Unity of the Valley has been served by a few transitional and full-time ministers, who were each here between one and three years. Throughout this time, we have always had the leadership of dedicated board members and the help of many volunteers.

During these transitions we remained financially solvent, adapted to include online offerings (during Covid) and recently partnered with an active Minister of Record, Rev. Phil Smedstad. With his guidance we made the decision to sell our building and use part of the substantial equity to set aside three-years-worth of a ministerial salary. As of July 2023, we are finalizing the building sale and intend to secure a new rental space to fit our current needs and budget.

Each Sunday, we continue to receive the gifts and messages shared by wonderfully talented speakers and musicians. One week each month, we gather for a potluck to enjoy community. Our Prayer Chaplains pray with individuals after the service each week, offer a weekly group meditation, and make monthly calls to requesting members. Additionally, we enjoy traditional special services such as the Burning Bowl and White Stone ceremonies and hands-on healing services. We also have a bookstore, regular book study, classes, and community volunteer events.

In the months since we voted to release our space, an uplifting energy has re-emerged. And as Unity Principles work, we are starting to see new faces at our Sunday Services. *How exciting!* We fervently believe there are many people hungry for our message and the tools to implement it.

Physical Description: Our current location near the Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul offers a wide variety of artistic, cultural, educational, and sporting events as well as beautiful lakes and parks. Minneapolis alone has 20 lakes and wetlands, the Minnesota Wildlife Refuge, and a park system with a chain of five lakes connected by bike, running, and walking paths. Minneapolis and St. Paul are home to the Walker Art Center, the Minneapolis Institute of Arts, and many theater companies including the Guthrie Theater, and along with our two main orchestras, there are countless opportunities to experience music and dance, with almost every city offering concerts in the summer. The professional sports teams of the Twins, Vikings, Timberwolves, Lynx, and Minnesota Wild are wonderfully entertaining. We have quality schools, colleges, and universities where people of all ages can learn and grow. The Mall of America, Minnesota Science Museum, Minnesota Children's Museum, three zoos, and several amusement parks provide fun for all. We experience four beautiful seasons, with many wonderful winter sports and activities such as ice skating, sledding and polar bear plunges! There's never a lack of things to do and enjoy here. You can drive just a few miles and be out among our green rolling hills or travel "up north" to the quiet splendor of lakes and pines. Come experience "Minnesota nice"!
